When driving outside outside a built-up area - vehicles transporting dangerous goods, heavy and (or) large vehicles - at a speed not exceeding the speed established when agreeing on the terms of transportation.

## WINTER EQUIPMENT

When driving from December 1 to March 1, vehicles with a maximum gross weight of up to 3.5 tons, passenger cars and cargo-passenger vehicles with a maximum gross weight over 3.5 tons, and buses with a maximum gross weight of up to 5 tons must be equipped with winter tires. Winter tires must be installed on all wheels of the vehicle.

Winter tires on motor vehicles designed for use on icy or snowy road surfaces are marked with a symbol depicting a mountain peak with three peaks and a snowflake inside it, and one of the symbols "M+S," "M&S," or "M S" (if there are no wear indicators). During use, the tires must have a residual tread depth of less than 4 mm.

## MANDATORY SAFETY EQUIPMENT

Vehicles must be equipped with:

a first aid kit, a fire extinguisher, a warning triangle, and, for trucks with a gross vehicle weight exceeding 3.5 tons and buses with a gross vehicle weight exceeding 5 tons, at least two wheel chocks.

Buses and trucks must be equipped with at least one fire extinguisher with a minimum capacity of 2 liters.

During daylight hours, low-beam headlights or daytime running lights must be turned on to indicate a moving vehicle. Every year from May 25 to June 5 and from August 25 to September 5.

## **DRIVING RESTRICTIONS**

There are no restrictions on the movement of vehicles on Sundays and holidays.

In accordance with the Decree of the President of the Republic of Belarus dated June 19, 2019 No. 239 «On the passage of heavy and (or) large-sized vehicles», the permissible axial masses (sums of axial masses) of vehicles under adverse weather (meteorological) conditions are established.

Due to the changing seasons and climate conditions, local authorities in a number of regions across the country are making decisions establishing temporary restrictions (prohibitions) on the movement of vehicles and self-propelled vehicles during the spring and summer periods, which are intended to ensure the preservation of the road surface, taking into account the reduced load-bearing capacity of the structural elements of local highways.

## **IMPORTATION OF FUEL**

Duty-free import of automobile fuel is allowed in the amount of full filling of tanks technologically connected to the engine.

## **TAXES AND FEES**

Since July 1, 2013, the Republic of Belarus has introduced an electronic system (BelToll) for tolling vehicles on certain roads of the Republic of Belarus or on certain sections thereof, including on sections of travel over bridges and other artificial structures.

Drivers driving the following types of vehicles are required to pay for travel on toll roads included in the BelToll system:

- motor vehicles with a technically permissible total weight of more than 3.5 tons (using an on-board unit installed on the inside of the windshield);
- motor vehicles with a technically permissible total weight of no more than 3.5 tons, not registered in the territory of the member states of the Eurasian Economic Union (using an electronic vignette).

Vehicles with a technically permissible total weight of no more than 3.5 tons, registered in the countries of the Eurasian Economic Union (Belarus, Russia, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan and Armenia), are exempt from tolls.

The on-board unit must be obtained before entering the toll road. To do this, you need to register the vehicle in the BelToll system. Registration is carried out at the customer service points.

The owner of the vehicle must sign an agreement for using the toll road and provide a set of necessary documents.

Toll collection for vehicles traveling on toll roads in the Republic of Belarus is regulated by Resolution No. 94 of the Ministry of Transport and Communications of the Republic of Belarus dated October 31, 2025, <https://pravo.by/document/?guid=12551&p0=W22544254> «On the Use of Toll Roads».

Tariffs for calculating the amount of toll for vehicles on the calculated segment of toll roads of the Republic of Belarus, tariffs for toll for vehicles for the period of use of toll roads of the Republic of Belarus, the amount of toll for vehicles on toll roads of the Republic of Belarus in an increased amount, the amount of toll for vehicles on toll

roads of the Republic of Belarus at a one-time tariff, as well as the cost of electronic vignettes and the deposit value of electronic devices for payment of toll roads, the list of fuel cards by means of which toll is collected for vehicles on toll roads of the Republic of Belarus in the pay-as-you-go mode, including toll at a one-time tariff, prepayments and the deposit value of the electronic payment device, as well as the fee for the electronic vignette, are retained at the same level.

The amount of the deposit is 50 euros. The collateral value is paid in Belarusian rubles at the official exchange rate of the National Bank of the Republic of Belarus on the day of payment.

The deposit for the on-board unit will be returned upon return of the device to any service point, except in cases provided for by law.

When receiving an on-board device under a contract in prepayment mode, you must top up the balance of the on-board device:

- the minimum device balance is 25 euros;
- the maximum balance on your account is 350 euros.

### **The following vehicles are exempt from paying tolls on toll roads included in the BelToll system:**

- vehicles registered on the territory of the EAEU member states (Belarus, Russia, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan and Armenia), with a technically permissible total weight of no more than 3.5 tons, and trailers towed by them;
- vehicles with a technically permissible total weight of not more than 3.5 tons, not registered in the territory of the member states of the Eurasian Economic Union, imported by individuals into the customs territory of the Eurasian Economic Union or purchased by individuals in the territory of the member states of the Eurasian Economic Union and imported into the territory of the Republic of Belarus, and the trailers towed by them - within 10 days, respectively, from the date of their release by customs authorities for the purpose of circulation in the customs territory of the Eurasian Economic Union without restrictions on use and disposal or from the date of their acquisition;
- vehicles with temporary (transit) registration plates issued in a foreign state, acquired by individual entrepreneurs or legal entities of the Republic of Belarus into ownership, economic management or operational management and imported into the territory of the Republic of Belarus;
- mopeds and motorcycles;
- wheeled tractors and self-propelled vehicles registered on the territory of the Republic of Belarus;
- operational vehicles;
- vehicles used to ensure defense capability and law and order;
- route vehicles carrying out urban transportation of passengers;
- vehicles used for emergency purposes.
- vehicles used for the purpose of transporting humanitarian aid to the population of the Republic of Belarus and other states.

## **CONDITIONS FOR PASSAGE OF HEAVY GOODS VEHICLES**

In accordance with the Decree of the President of the Republic of Belarus dated June 19, 2019 No. 239 “On the passage of heavy and (or) large-sized vehicles” it is established:

toll rates for heavy and (or) large-sized vehicles (HLSV) on roads exceeding the permissible total weight of the vehicle by more than 2 percent are determined at 0.003 base value for each full ton of excess per kilometer of distance and 0.001 base value for less than a full ton of excess per kilometer of distance;

toll rates for HLSV travel on roads exceeding the permissible axle weight on single, dual and triple axles of the vehicle in accordance with Appendix 2;

toll rates for HLSV travel on roads exceeding the permissible axle weight for each adjacent axle of a vehicle that has more than three axles with single and double wheels, and also has four or more double or single wheels on an axle with a distance between the wheel axles of more than 0,7 meters or six or more wheels on an axle with a distance between the wheel axles of less than 0.7 meters, in accordance with Appendix 3;

toll rates for HLSV travel on roads with vehicle dimensions exceeding the permissible dimensions in accordance with Appendix 4;

the amount of the increase in the toll rates for heavy and (or) oversized vehicles on highways in the cases specified in parts one through three of paragraph 9 of the Regulation on tolls for heavy and (or) oversized vehicles on highways, approved by this Decree, shall be determined in accordance with Appendix 6;

if it is necessary to drive a vehicle exceeding the permissible weight and (or) dimensional parameters established by this Decree, with the exception of the cases specified in subclause 1.10 of this clause, the owner (user) of the HLSV is obliged to obtain a special permit in advance (before participating in road traffic) or to provide its receipt by the persons specified in part two of this subparagraph.

when participating in HLSV road traffic, except for the cases specified in subparagraphs 1.10 and 1.11 of this paragraph, a driver is obliged to carry with him and present for inspection to officials of authorized regulatory bodies the original special permit on paper or a copy of it certified by the organization that issued the special permit.

In the cases specified in subparagraphs 1.10 and 1.11 of this paragraph, the HLSV driver is required to carry and present for verification a document confirming payment of the HLSV toll on roads. Moreover, in the case specified in subparagraph 1.11 of this paragraph, the HLSV driver is obliged to inform officials of the authorized regulatory authorities information about the number and date of receipt of the special permit in electronic form;

A driver has the right to drive on roads without special permit if:

the HLSV entered the territory of the Republic of Belarus through the customs border of the Eurasian Economic Union in the Republic of Belarus (hereinafter referred to as the customs border) and the excess of the permissible total mass and (or) permissible axial mass (sum of axial masses) is up to 10 percent inclusive;

the Transport Inspectorate of the Ministry of Transport and Communications (hereinafter referred to as the Transport Inspectorate) allowed the further movement of the detained HLSV in accordance with paragraph 11 of the Regulations approved by this Decree;

a HLSV driver has the right to drive on highways without a special permit on paper if a special permit is issued electronically in the manner established by the Ministry of Transport and Communications jointly with the State Customs Committee.

An application from the owner (user) of a heavy and/or oversized vehicle for a special permit for the HLSV to travel on public roads is submitted electronically through the unified electronic services portal of the national automated information system.

A special permit for the HLSV to travel on public roads of the Republic of Belarus is issued electronically through the automated information system of the BeldorCenter RUE, which is integrated with the national automated information system. The electronically issued special permit in .pdf format is posted on the unified electronic services portal of the national automated information system in the HLSV owner's (user's) personal account for downloading and printing.

If a special permit is issued electronically, the HLSV driver must have the permit number and date of receipt. If a special permit is issued on paper, the original permit or a copy certified by an authorized organization (Republican Unitary Enterprise "Beldorcenter") must be kept by the HLSV driver.

## **TRANSPORTATION OF DANGEROUS GOODS**

International transportation of dangerous goods through the territory of the Republic of Belarus (transit transportation of dangerous goods through the territory of the Republic of Belarus, export of dangerous goods from the Republic of Belarus, import into the Republic of Belarus) is carried out in compliance with the requirements established by the Agreement on the International Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road (ADR), other international conventions and intergovernmental agreements (treaties), to which the Republic of Belarus is a party.

## **TRANSPORTATION ACROSS THE CUSTOMS BORDER OF THE REPUBLIC OF BELARUS OF CERTAIN TYPES OF GOODS**

In order to ensure the national security of the Republic of Belarus, protect human life or health, the environment, respect for public morality and law and order, protect cultural values, as well as fulfill the international obligations of the Republic of Belarus, the Resolution of the Council of Ministers of the Republic of Belarus dated September 23, 2008 No. 1397 approved the procedure for moving certain types of goods across the customs border of the Republic of Belarus:

- Regulations on the procedure and conditions for the issuance by the Ministry of Agriculture and Food of the Republic of Belarus of conclusions (permits) for the import of plant protection products into the Republic of Belarus;
- Regulations on the procedure and conditions for the issuance by the Ministry of Natural Resources and Environmental Protection of conclusions (permits) for the export of wild animals and wild plants belonging to the species included in the Red Book of the Republic of Belarus, their parts and (or) derivatives restricted for movement through The state border of the Republic of Belarus on non-economic grounds;
- Regulations on the procedure and conditions for the Ministry of Health issuing conclusions (permits) for the import of medicines into the territory of the Republic of Belarus;
- Regulations on the procedure and conditions for issuing permits for the import and (or) export of narcotic drugs, psychotropic substances and their precursors, restricted for movement across the State Border of the Republic of Belarus on non-economic grounds;

- Regulations on the procedure for the Ministry of Health to issue conclusions (permits) for the import into the customs territory of the Eurasian Economic Union in the Republic of Belarus, the export from this territory of human organs and tissues, blood and its components (attached);

- Regulations on the procedure for the Ministry of Health to issue conclusions (permits) for the import into the Republic of Belarus, export from the Republic of Belarus, transit through its territory of opportunistic and pathogenic genetically engineered organisms.

## **ROAD TRANSPORT CONTROL**

Vehicle control at road checkpoints of the Republic of Belarus with foreign countries is carried out by the customs authorities of the Republic of Belarus.

The procedure for carrying out vehicle control at road checkpoints on the state border of the Republic of Belarus with foreign states was approved by the Resolution of the Council of Ministers of the Republic of Belarus No. 71 of January 27, 2014.

To pass vehicle inspection at a road border checkpoint, the owner (user) of the vehicle must present to the customs official:

vehicle registration certificate (technical passport, vehicle registration card);

a document confirming the right of ownership (use) of the vehicle, if the road carrier is not the owner of the vehicle;

a special permit or information about its number and date of receipt in electronic form, except for cases specified in subparagraph 1.10 of paragraph 1 of Decree of the President of the Republic of Belarus No. 239 of June 19, 2019;

a weighing receipt or weighing certificate, if available;

an international consignment note (CMR) - for international road transport of goods;

a route map, schedule, and a permit for international road transport of passengers on regular services - for international road transport of passengers on regular services;

A document (trip form) containing a list of passengers, information about the motor carrier, the bus, its crew, and the route of transportation – when performing international passenger transportation by road on an irregular basis.

If customs authorities do not have information provided by the Ministry of Transport and Communications regarding the issuance of a special permit, the number of which is provided by the owner (user) of the vehicle in accordance with paragraph four of part one of this clause, the owner (user) of the vehicle shall present such special permit or a copy thereof, certified by a government agency authorized to issue special permits in accordance with administrative procedure legislation.

In addition to the documents and information listed in parts one and two of this paragraph, the owner (user) of a foreign vehicle shall submit:

a permit for the passage of foreign motor vehicles through the territory of the Republic of Belarus, or a unique travel code for an ECMT permit generated by the ECMT digital permit system, or a multiple-entry permit for the passage of foreign motor vehicles through the territory of the Republic of Belarus, with the exception of cases specified in paragraph 7 of these Regulations,

for freight vehicles:

a permit for the performance of international passenger road transport on an irregular basis, with the exception of cases specified in paragraph 7 of these Regulations,

for the performance of international passenger road transport on an irregular basis;

certificates of conformity of the vehicle and trailer (semi-trailer) with technical specifications concerning harmful emissions and noise, safety requirements, roadworthiness, and other requirements for the vehicle and trailer (semi-trailer) - for the performance of international road transport (trip) under a permit establishing the relevant restrictions and conditions.

The owner (user) of a vehicle entering the Republic of Belarus and traveling to other member states of the Eurasian Economic Union (hereinafter referred to as the EAEU) or transiting through the territory of other EAEU member states, in addition to the documents and information listed in parts one through three of this paragraph, shall submit the following documents issued by the EAEU member states through whose territory the vehicle will be transited:

a permit to travel through the territory of the relevant EAEU member states;

a special permit for the transportation of oversized and/or heavy cargo, or transit by HLSV - if the permissible weight and/or dimensions of the vehicle, as established by the EAEU member states through whose territory the vehicle will be transited, are exceeded;

a special permit for the transportation of dangerous goods - for the transportation of dangerous goods.

The owner (user) of a vehicle leaving the Republic of Belarus and traveling from other EAEU member states through the territory of the Republic of Belarus in transit, in addition to the documents and information listed in parts one through three of this paragraph, shall submit:

a receipt for payment of fees for the vehicle's travel on the roads of other EAEU member states through whose territory the travel was carried out, if the payment of such fees is mandatory in accordance with their legislation;

a receipt confirming the payment of a fine for violating the procedure for performing international road transport in the territory of other EAEU member states, or a decision of a judicial body satisfying an appeal against a ruling on

the imposition of an administrative penalty in cases where the permit for travel through the territory of other EAEU member states or the registration coupon contains a mark from the transport (automobile) control authority of the EAEU member states on the tax imposing such an administrative penalty;

a document certifying the vehicle's approval for international road transport, if such a document is mandatory under the legislation of the EAEU Member State in which the vehicle is registered;

documents specified in the notification issued by the transport (automobile) control authority of another EAEU Member State, if the customs authority receives information about the issuance of such a notification;

documents issued by the EAEU Member States through whose territory the vehicle was traveled;

permit for travel through the territory of the relevant EAEU Member States;

a special permit for the transportation of oversized and/or heavy cargo, travel by HLSV - if the permissible weight and/or dimensions of the vehicle, established by the EAEU Member States through whose territory the vehicle was traveled, are exceeded;

a special permit for the transportation of dangerous goods - for the transportation of dangerous goods.

When conducting vehicle control at a road checkpoint, a customs official has the right to request additional documents and information for the purpose of verifying the information contained in the documents specified in this paragraph.

## **VETERINARY CONTROL**

Resolution of the Ministry of Agriculture and Food of the Republic of Belarus dated 19.05.2017 No. 32 approved the forms of:

veterinary certificates for the purpose of exporting goods subject to veterinary control (supervision) from the customs territory of the Eurasian Economic Union in accordance with Appendix 1;

veterinary certificates for the movement of goods subject to veterinary control (supervision) within the territory of the Republic of Belarus in accordance with Appendices 2, 3;

veterinary certificates for export to the countries of the Commonwealth of Independent States, with the exception of the member states of the Eurasian Economic Union, of goods subject to veterinary control (supervision) in accordance with Appendix 4.

Veterinary supervision at the state border is carried out by the State institution "Belarusian Department of State Veterinary Control at the State Border and Transport" of the Department of Veterinary and Food Supervision of the Ministry of Agriculture and Food of the Republic of Belarus:

Resolution of the Council of Ministers of the Republic of Belarus dated September 23, 2008 No. 1397 approved the Regulations on the procedure and conditions for issuing permits for import into the customs territory and transit through the customs territory of the Eurasian Economic Union of controlled goods by the Department of Veterinary and Food Supervision of the Ministry of Agriculture and Food.

## **PHYTOSANITARY CONTROL**

By decision of the Customs Union Commission dated June 18, 2010 No. 318, the Regulations on the procedure for implementing quarantine phytosanitary control (supervision) at the customs border of the Eurasian Economic Union and the Regulations on the procedure for implementing quarantine phytosanitary control (supervision) on the customs territory of the Eurasian Economic Union were approved.

## **MANDATORY DISINFECTION OF VEHICLES**

In accordance with Decree No. 154 of the President of the Republic of Belarus dated April 26, 2022, "On Mandatory Disinfection of Vehicles," vehicles entering the territory of the Republic of Belarus are subject to mandatory disinfection.

Vehicles entering Belarus through the Benyakoni, Grigorovshchina, Kamenny Log, Kozlovichi, Kotlovka, and Privalka checkpoints are subject to mandatory disinfection.

This requirement will apply to the Novaya Guta and Urbany checkpoints once traffic resumes.

Control stamps are purchased at checkpoints from the Belarusian Republican Unitary Insurance Company Belgosstrakh, the Belarusbank Savings Bank Open Joint-Stock Company, BelGlobalGarant LLC, and other sales outlets organized by BelGlobalGarant LLC.

Electronic control stamps are purchased through the electronic information system, including at self-service payment terminals at checkpoints.

When selling electronic control stamps through the electronic information system, payment is made using payment methods and/or payment instruments, including at self-service payment terminals.

Upon entering the Republic of Belarus, the driver or owner of a vehicle presents a control stamp or electronic control stamp to a border service officer at a checkpoint. Drivers or owners of vehicles subject to border control by customs authorities present a control stamp to customs officials.

The border service officer (customs official) verifies the presence and integrity of the control stamp or the validity of the electronic control stamp of the driver or owner of the vehicle entering the Republic of Belarus. The border service officer (customs official) tampers with the control stamp and returns it to the presenter, or cancels the electronic control stamp through the electronic information system.

## **CUSTOMS ESCORT OF GOODS MOVED BY ROAD TRANSPORT THROUGH THE TERRITORY OF THE REPUBLIC OF BELARUS**

The customs authorities of the Republic of Belarus have the right to use customs escort:

1) when transporting goods in accordance with the customs procedure of customs transit in the following cases: failure to provide, in accordance with Article 146 of this Code, security for the fulfillment of the obligation to pay import customs duties, taxes, special, anti-dumping, countervailing duties, or provision of security for the fulfillment of such obligation in an amount less than the amount determined in accordance with Article 146 of this Code;

repeated failure by the carrier to fulfill obligations when transporting goods in accordance with the customs procedure of customs transit, which was established by decisions on bringing into administrative liability that have entered into legal force, if at least one of these decisions is not executed;

failure by the carrier to fulfill, within the established period, the obligation to pay import customs duties, taxes, special, anti-dumping, countervailing duties in accordance with Article 153 of this Code;

other cases when signs of non-compliance with international treaties and acts constituting the law of the Union and (or) the legislation of the Member States are identified;

2) when transporting foreign goods under customs control, when, in accordance with this Code, such goods can be transported through the customs territory of the Union without being placed under the customs procedure of customs transit.

If the customs authority makes a decision to use customs escort, the customs authority informs the carrier about such a decision and organizes customs escort no later than 24 hours from the moment such a decision is made.

The procedure for organizing customs escort through the territory of the Republic of Belarus is regulated by the norms of the resolution of the Council of Ministers of the Republic of Belarus dated May 27, 2014. No. 509 "On measures to implement the Law of the Republic of Belarus "On measures to implement the Law of the Republic of Belarus "On customs regulation in the Republic of Belarus".

In accordance with clause 2. Art. 228 of the Law of the Republic of Belarus dated January 10, 2014 No. 129-Z "On customs regulation in the Republic of Belarus", organizations carrying out customs escort of vehicles transporting foreign goods in accordance with the customs procedure of customs transit bear a joint responsibility with the declarant of the customs procedure of customs transit payment of import customs duties, taxes, special, anti-dumping, countervailing duties.

## **MANDATORY ESCORT FOR CERTAIN GOODS IN THE TERRITORY OF THE REPUBLIC OF BELARUS**

1. In accordance with Article 23 of the [Law](#) of the Republic of Belarus dated August 27, 2008. No. 429-Z "On state regulation of the production and turnover of alcoholic, non-edible alcohol-containing products and non-edible ethyl alcohol" (hereinafter referred to as the Law) are subject to mandatory support in the manner prescribed by law by units of the Security Department of the Ministry of Internal Affairs (when transported by road) or by the

paramilitary guards of the Belarusian Railway roads (when transported by rail) alcoholic products, as well as non-edible alcohol-containing products and non-edible ethyl alcohol according to the list of goods specified in part three of this paragraph:

imported into the territory of the Republic of Belarus from the territory of member states of the Eurasian Economic Union, including through the territory of a state that is not a member of the Eurasian Economic Union, transported through the territory of the Republic of Belarus;

intended for export from the territory of the Republic of Belarus to the territory of member states of the Eurasian Economic Union, including through the territory of a state that is not a member of the Eurasian Economic Union, transported through the territory of the Republic of Belarus.

The requirements of part one of this paragraph do not apply to:

imported alcoholic beverages marked with excise stamps;

imported (exported) alcoholic, non-food alcohol-containing products for use as samples and exhibits at exhibitions and fairs in a volume of no more than 2.5 liters of each item;

import of alcoholic products as samples for testing as part of assessing compliance with technical requirements in the quantity established by technical regulatory legal acts in the field of technical regulation and standardization;

import by producers of alcoholic beverages of samples of alcoholic beverages planned for delivery to assess their quality (tests) and organoleptic indicators;

non-edible ethyl alcohol imported by petroleum product producers in a volume of no more than 30 deciliters for use in testing the petroleum products produced;

other cases of transportation of alcoholic, non-food alcohol-containing products and non-food ethyl alcohol, determined by the President of the Republic of Belarus or on his instructions by the Council of Ministers of the Republic of Belarus.

The list of goods indicating the code of the Commodity Nomenclature of Foreign Economic Activity of the Republic of Belarus related to non-food alcohol-containing products and non-food ethyl alcohol, to which mandatory support applies, was approved by Resolution of the Council of Ministers of the Republic of Belarus dated March 27, 2007 N 381.

In accordance with paragraph 2 of the resolution of the Council of Ministers of the Republic of Belarus dated March 27, 2007. No. 381, mandatory escort of goods related to non-edible alcohol-containing products and transported using the TIR procedure is carried out in accordance with the 1975 TIR Convention.

Also subject to mandatory escort in the manner established by the legislation of the Republic of Belarus by the Security Department of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Republic of Belarus, rectified technical ethyl alcohol, denatured ethyl alcohol, obtained from food or non-food raw materials, produced on the territory of the Republic of Belarus, transported by road transport across the territory of the Republic of Belarus in an amount of more than 100 deciliters (clause 2 of article 23 of the Law of the Republic of Belarus dated August 27, 2008 No. 429-Z "On state regulation of the production and turnover of alcoholic, non-food alcohol-containing products and non-food ethyl alcohol"). In this case, mandatory support may not be carried out in the specified cases when using navigation devices (seals) that operate through information systems that provide remote control over the movement of vehicles and compliance with the established route for the transportation of goods, provided by the national operator of the system for tracking (monitoring) international transit transportation of goods using navigation devices (seals) (clause 3, article 23 of the Law of the Republic of Belarus dated August 27, 2008 No. 429-Z "On state regulation of the production and circulation of alcoholic, non-food alcohol-containing products and non-food ethyl alcohol").

2. Raw tobacco and tobacco products transported in transit through the territory of the Republic of Belarus are subject to mandatory escort in the manner prescribed by law by units of the Security Department of the Ministry of Internal Affairs (when moving by road) and the militarized guards of the Belarusian Railway (when moving by rail). This is determined by paragraph 24 of the Decree of the President of the Republic of Belarus dated December 17, 2002. No. 28 "On state regulation of the production, circulation and consumption of raw tobacco and tobacco products."

#### **Rates of fees for escort (mandatory escort) of goods and vehicles transported under customs control in the Republic of Belarus**

1. In accordance with Decree of the President of the Republic of Belarus dated July 13, 2006 No. 443 "On customs duties", the following rates of customs duties for customs escort of goods carried out by officials of customs authorities are established:

Name of customs duty	Rate of customs duties for customs escort, in euros (at the rate of the National Bank of the Republic of Belarus)
Fee for customs escort using the carrier's transport (for each full and partial hour of customs escort)	

Fee for customs escort using one unit of transport of the customs authority (for each full and partial hour of customs escort)	50
Fee for customs escort using two units of transport of the customs authority (for each full and partial hour of customs escort)	100

2. In accordance with the Resolution of the Council of Ministers of the Republic of Belarus dated July 4, 2006 No. 829 "On the establishment of tariffs for escort services (customs escort, mandatory escort) of goods and (or) vehicles transported across the territory of the Republic of Belarus by road, and services for mandatory escort of protected goods transported across the territory of the Republic of Belarus by rail", the following rate of fees for escort of goods and vehicles transported under customs control is established:

0.05 basic value per 1 kilometer of travel, but not less than 1 basic value per 1 vehicle used for transporting goods or traveling as goods under its own power.

The specified fee rate is applied when escorting goods and vehicles by units of the Security Department of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Republic of Belarus and Beltamozhconvoy of Beltamozhservice.

In accordance with the provisions of the Resolution of the Council of Ministers of the Republic of Belarus dated December 5, 2024 No. 899 "On Amending the Resolution of the Council of Ministers of the Republic of Belarus dated January 22, 2009 No. 70", vehicles subject to customs escort are no longer allowed to enter checkpoints without queuing due to failure to provide security for the fulfillment of the obligation to pay customs duties and other payments in accordance with the Customs Code of the EAEU. At the same time, the right of priority entry into road checkpoints will be retained for vehicles subject to customs escort on other grounds provided for by law.
